As of right now, the conservative republicans in the State House are two votes shy of repealing Prevailing Wage Law in the State of Ohio. Local 860 members and the members of every Union in the State of Ohio need to realize that if this happens, your wages could be dramatically cut and would seriously affect your standard of living.

Not all republicans are against Working Families on the Prevailing Wage Issue, we do have some republican friends that are helping with this fight and we appreciate all of their efforts; however, our members must realize that these politicians that Local 860 endorse are Pro-Union and will not vote against Prevailing Wage. It is imperative that our Union members recognize their responsibility to their families and the Working Families across the State of Ohio and continue to elect Union friendly politicians.
